



To whom it may concern,

We are considering employing a summer intern for the position of Field Service Intern here at Cardinal Environmental. Please note that this is **NOT** a laboratory position.

The intern would be working under the direction of and supervised by our Field Service Manager, Dustin Kasbaum. Below are the primary duties of the Field Service Intern:

Field Service Intern Duties

- Work with Manufacturing and Industry ranging from Green Bay to Milwaukee and Fon du Lac to assist with ongoing environmental compliance
 - Collect well samples at various landfill locations within 60 miles of Sheboygan, WI.
 - Provide sample courier services
- Collect waste water discharge samples for environmental compliance analysis (the intern will spend the majority of the summer on waste water projects)
 - Collect non-contact cooling water samples for environmental compliance analysis
 - Perform storm water inspections including compliance reports
 - Collect other solid and liquid waste samples for compliance analysis
 - Clean and repair various sampling/analytical equipment
 - Generate communications with customers communicating analytical results
- Assist laboratory personnel with analytical testing when needed (ex. Wet Chemistry)
 - Computer literacy with Microsoft Word and Excel required
- ability to develop a general understanding of the municipal interceptor service systems, local sanitary and storm sewer systems, industrial waste pretreatment systems, and the Wisconsin Pollution Discharge Elimination System (WPDES) regulatory requirements

- Perform Waste water and Stormwater project inspections under the supervision of the Field Service Manager
 - Demonstrated ability to read technical documents
 - Ability to work independently and in a team environment to meet deadlines
- Possession of a valid Wisconsin driver's license and reliable transportation (use of personal vehicle for fieldwork may be required)
 - And other duties as directed by supervisor

Preference will be given to those whose university program requires an internship as a condition of graduation. Special requirements include the physical agility and flexibility needed to perform field sampling and investigations, and the dexterity and vision needed to operate computer equipment with a high degree of proficiency. Criminal and/or personal background checks may be performed. Use of illegal drugs or abuse of legal drugs will prevent or terminate the internship
